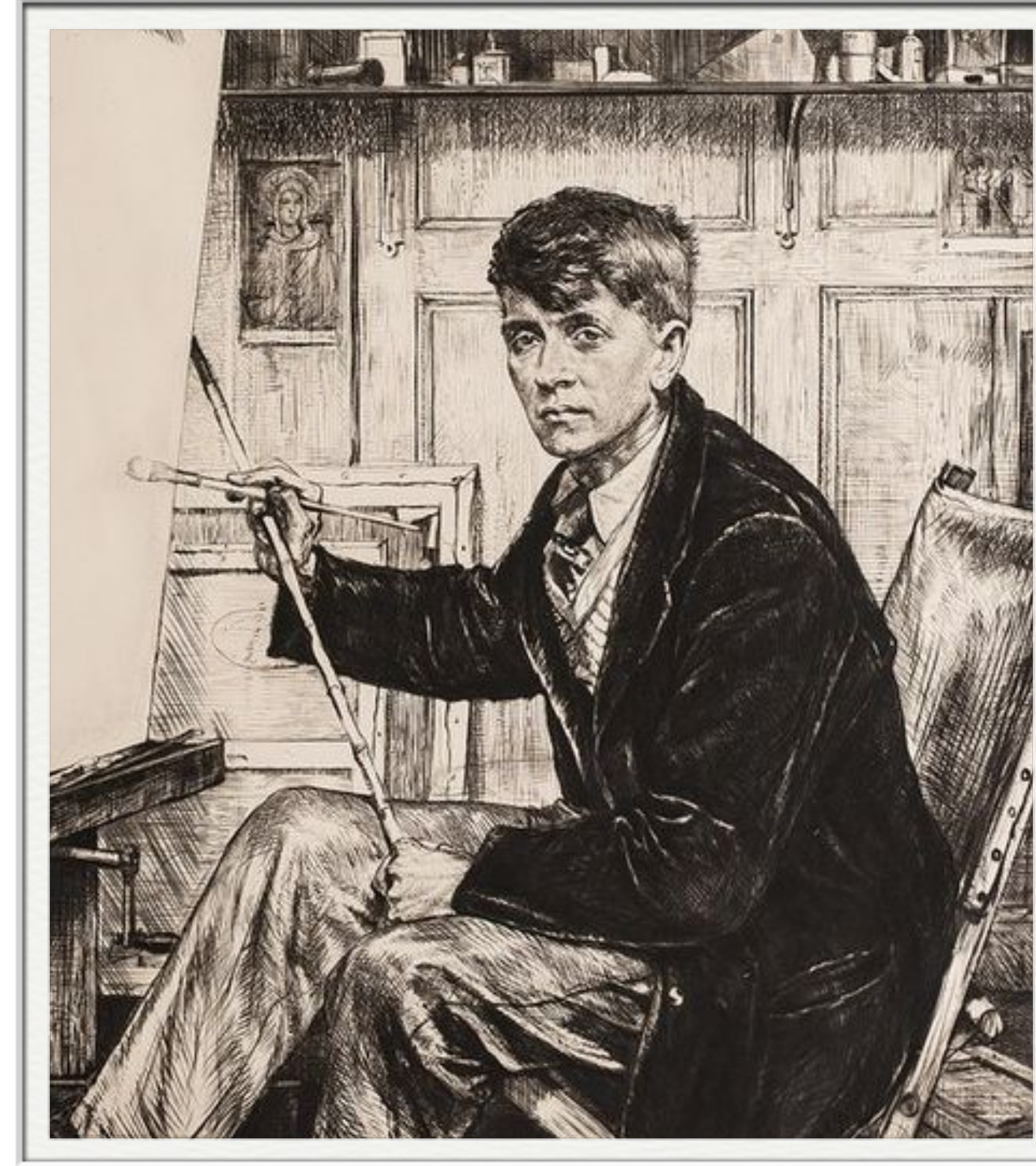

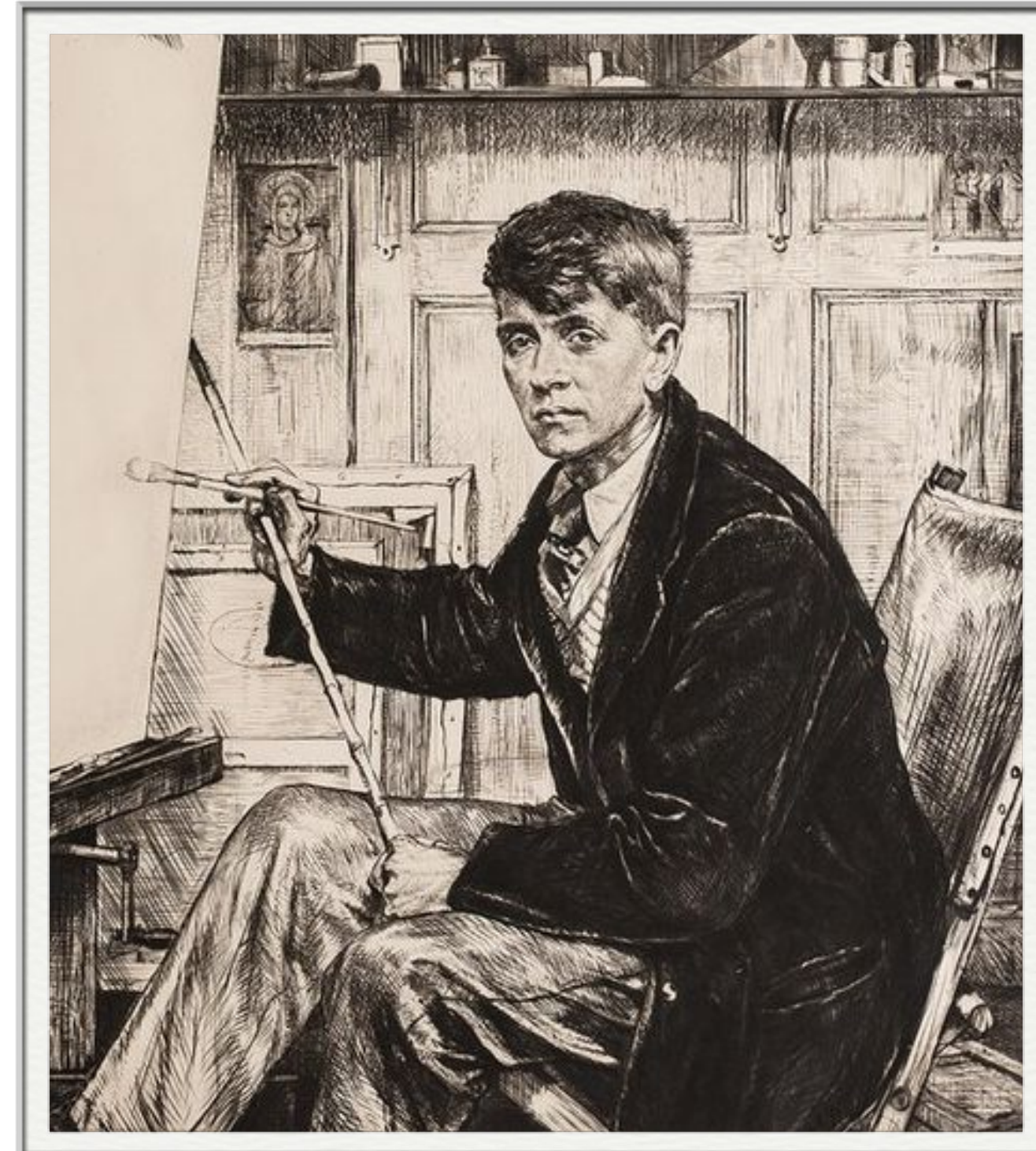

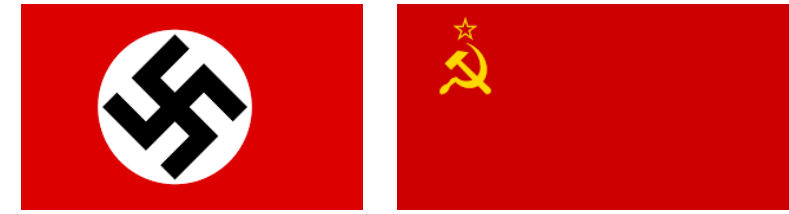

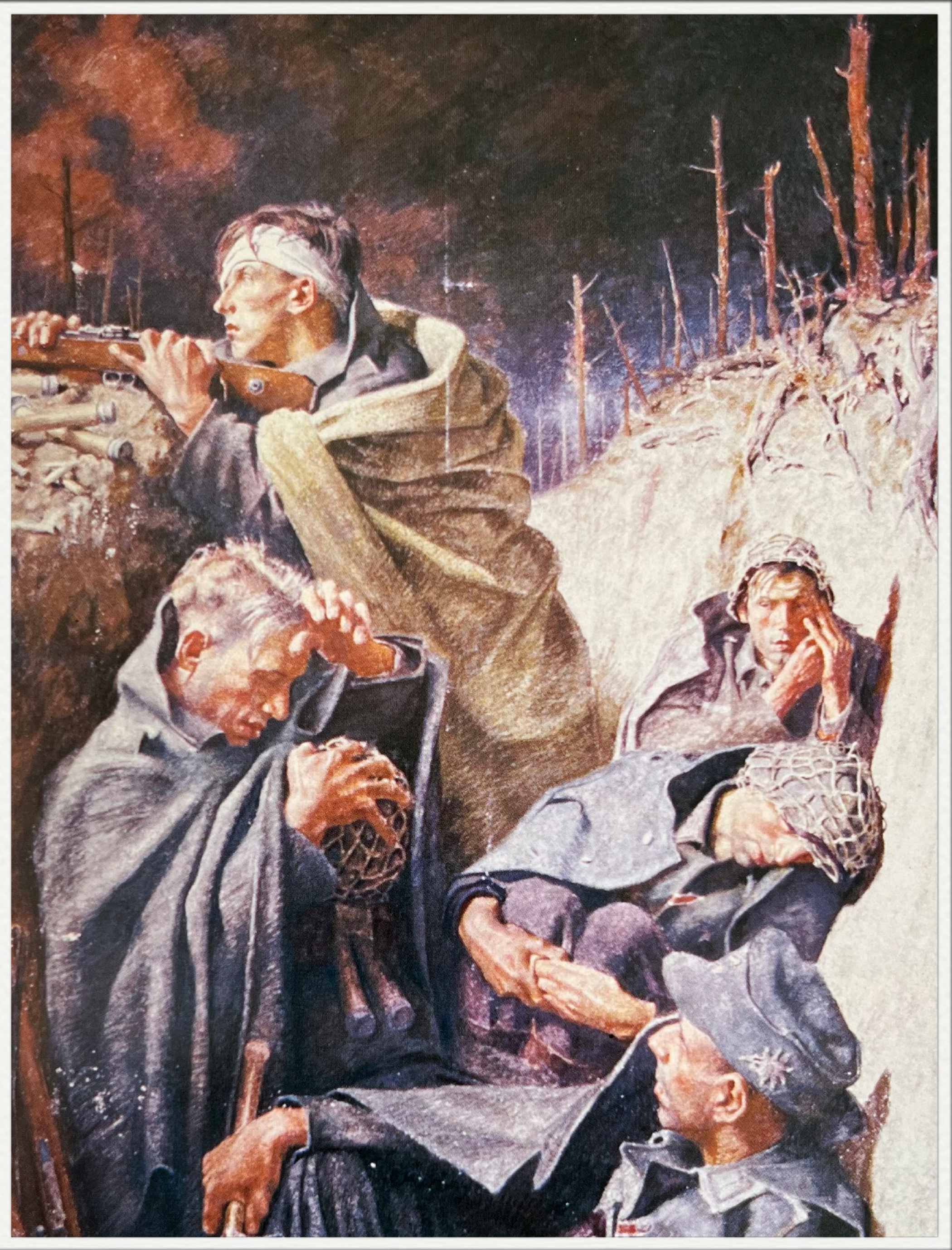

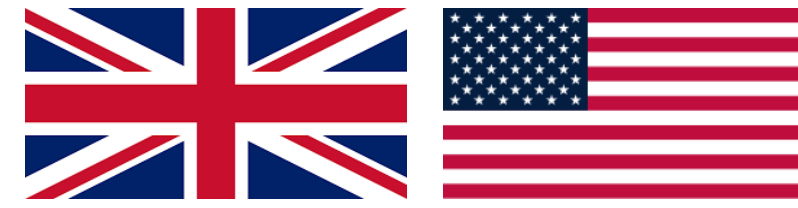

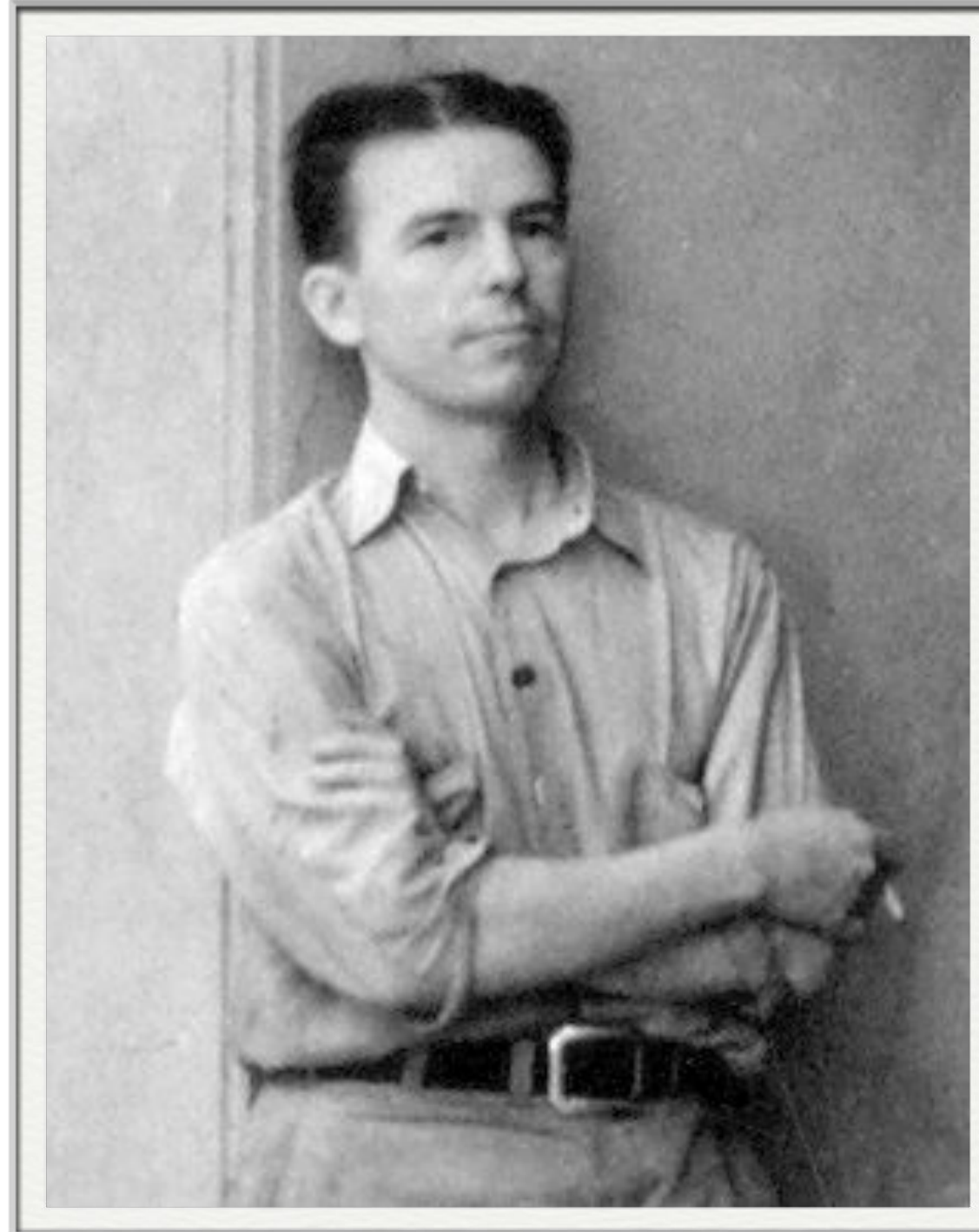

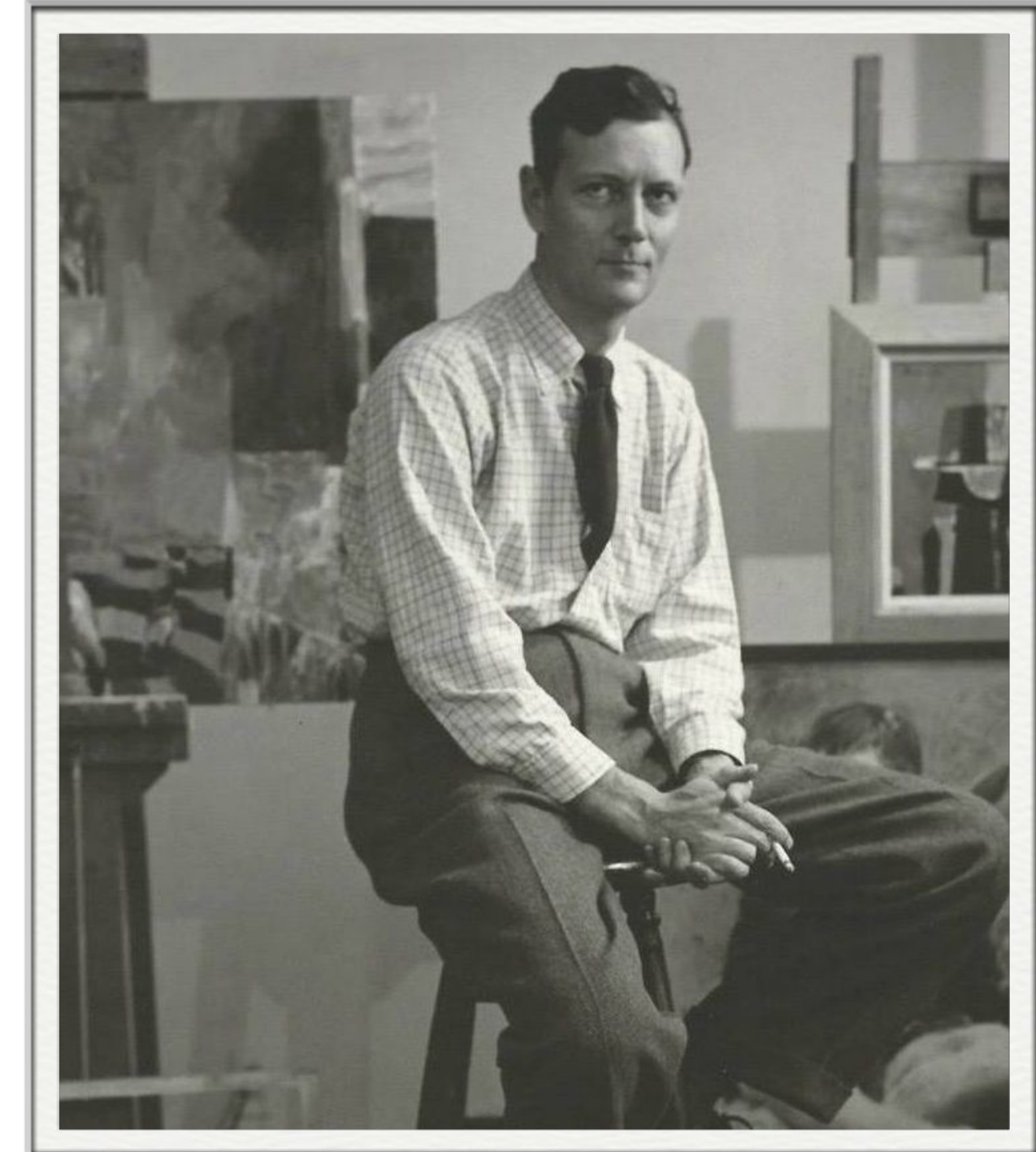

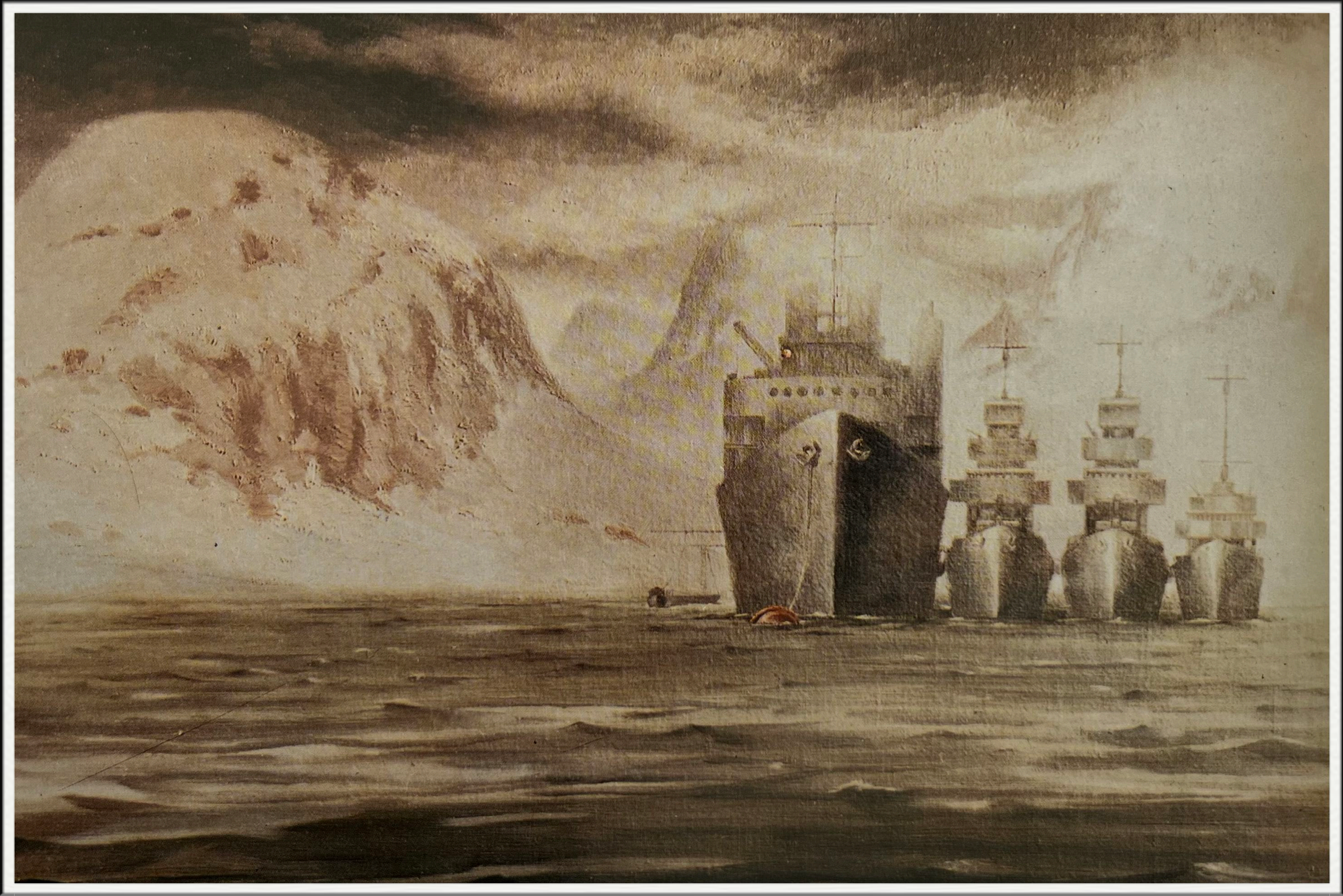

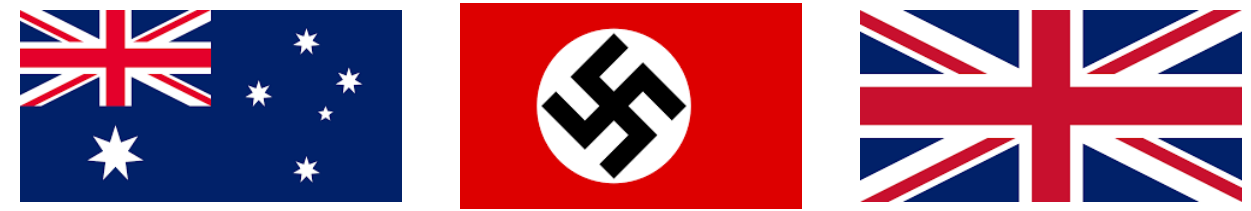


"Patrol out of Iceland" 1943, Tom Lea

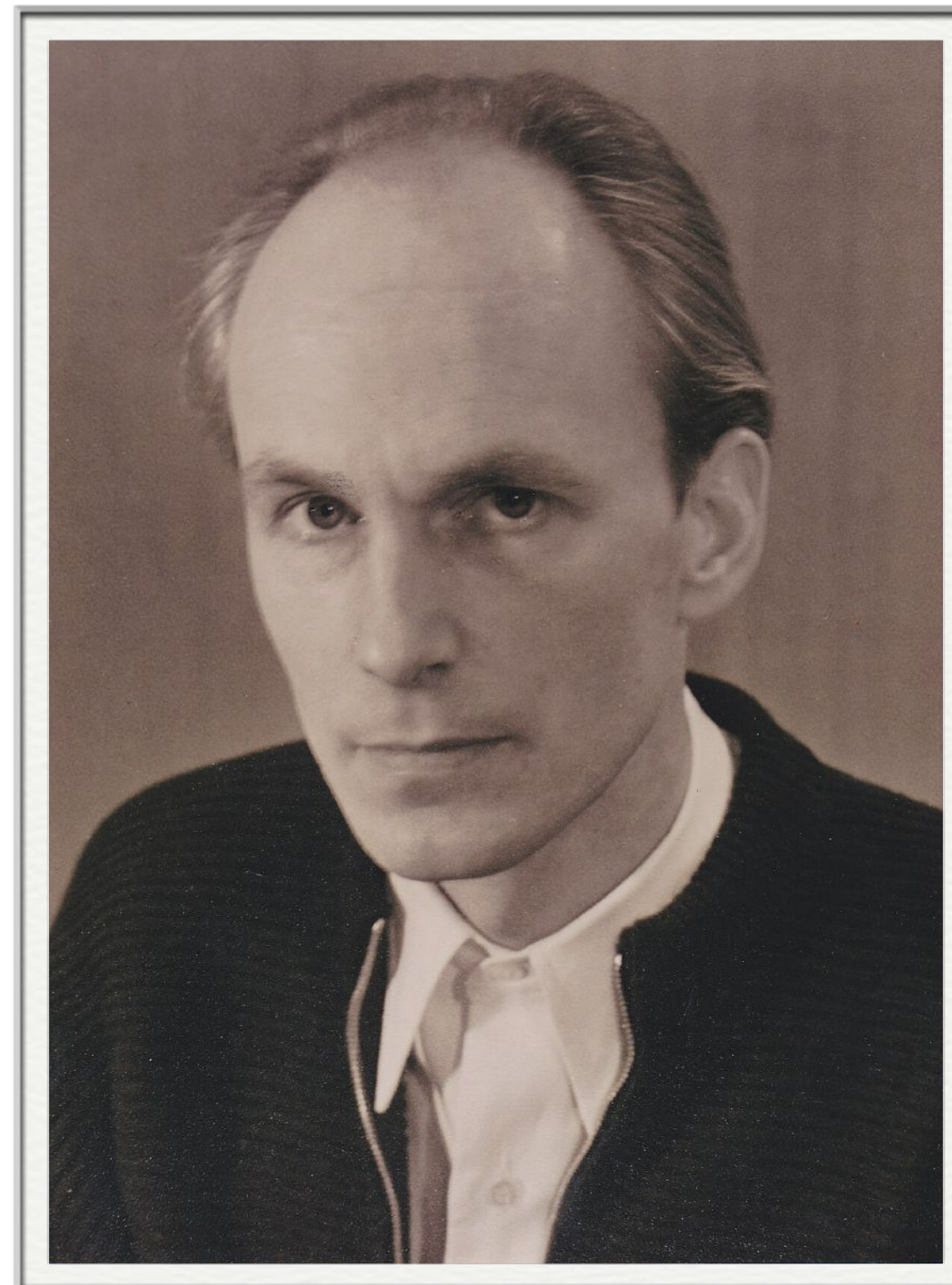

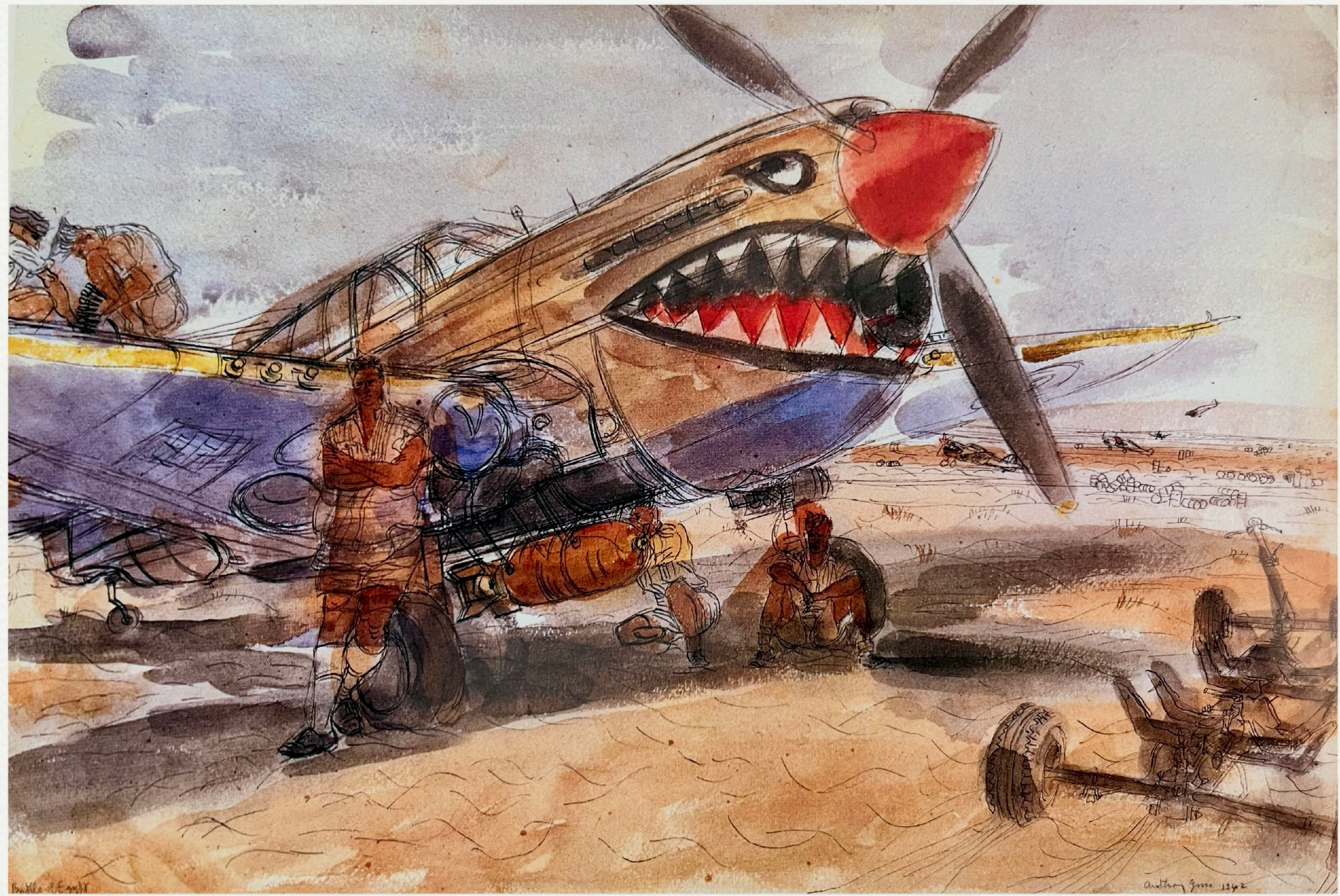

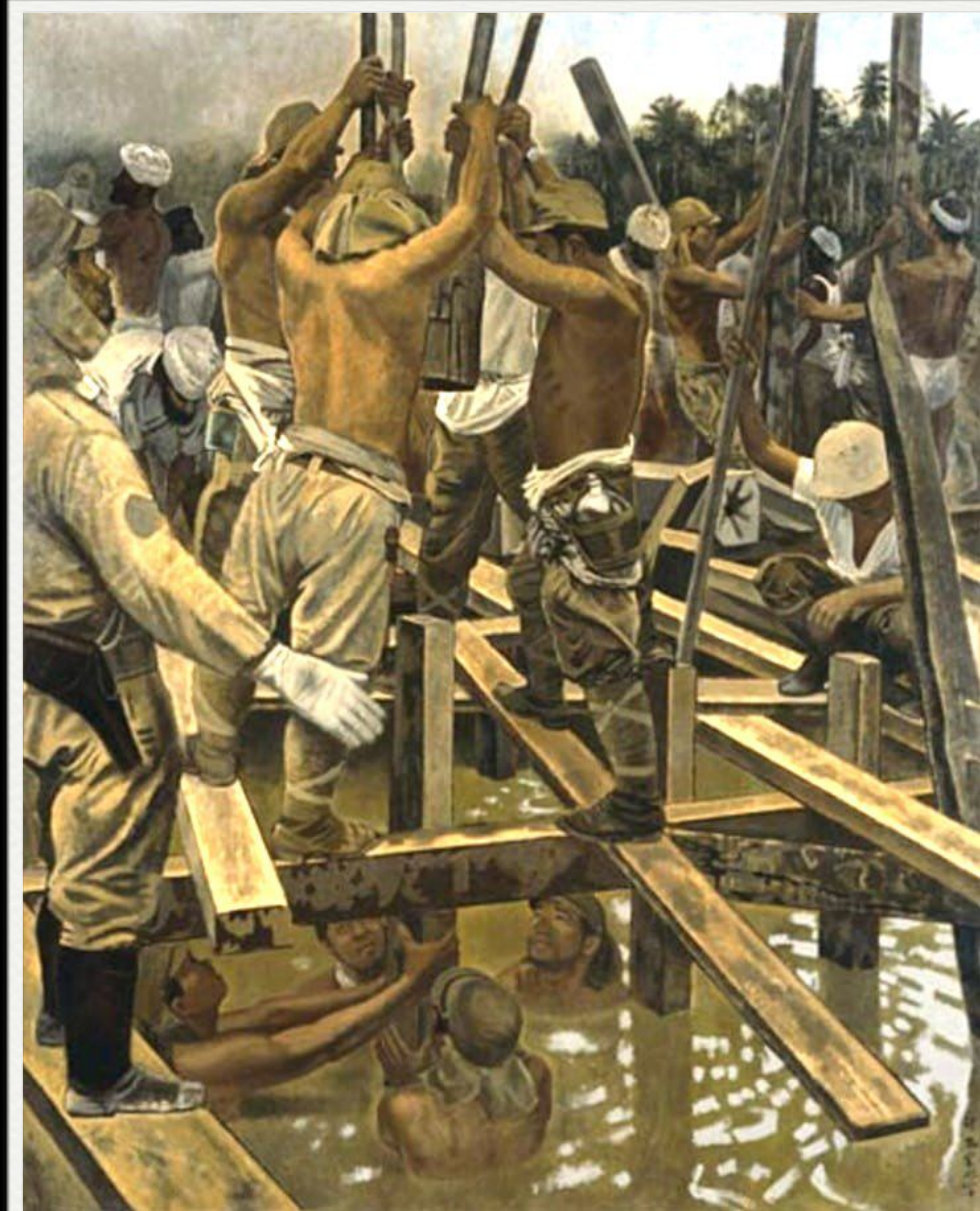

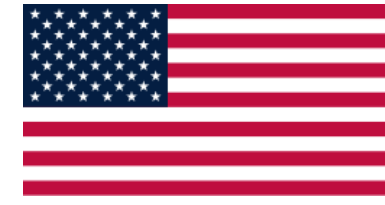

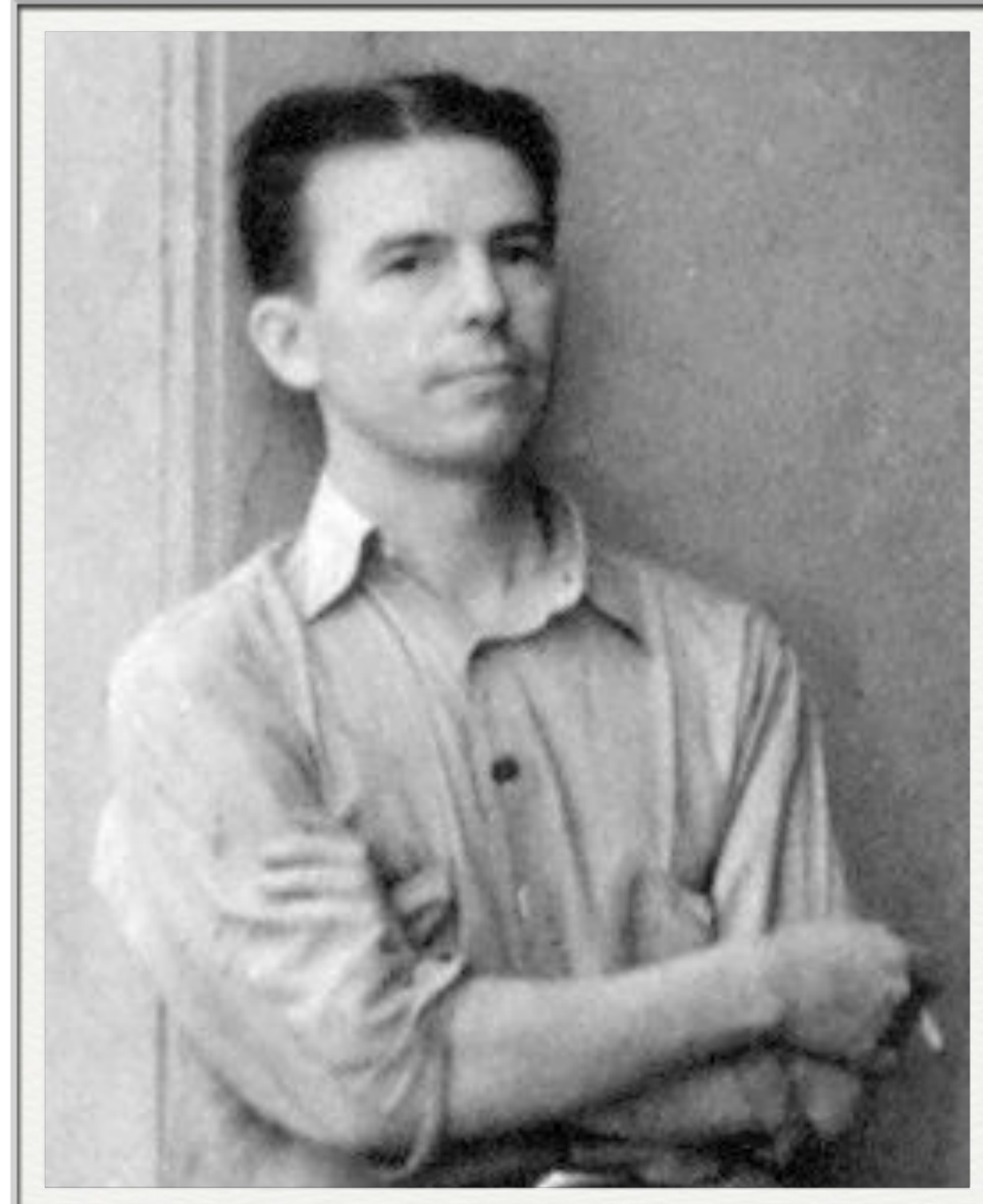

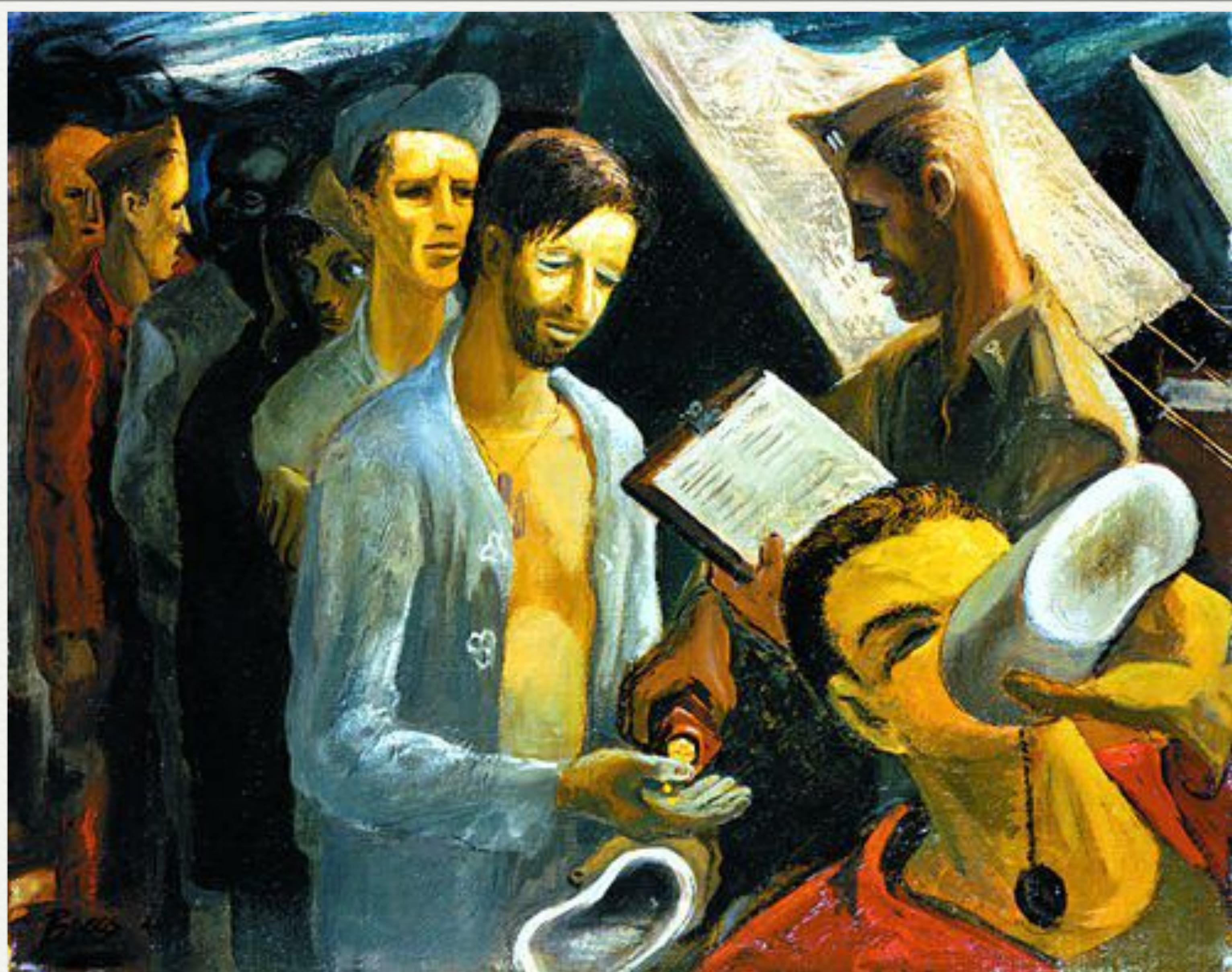

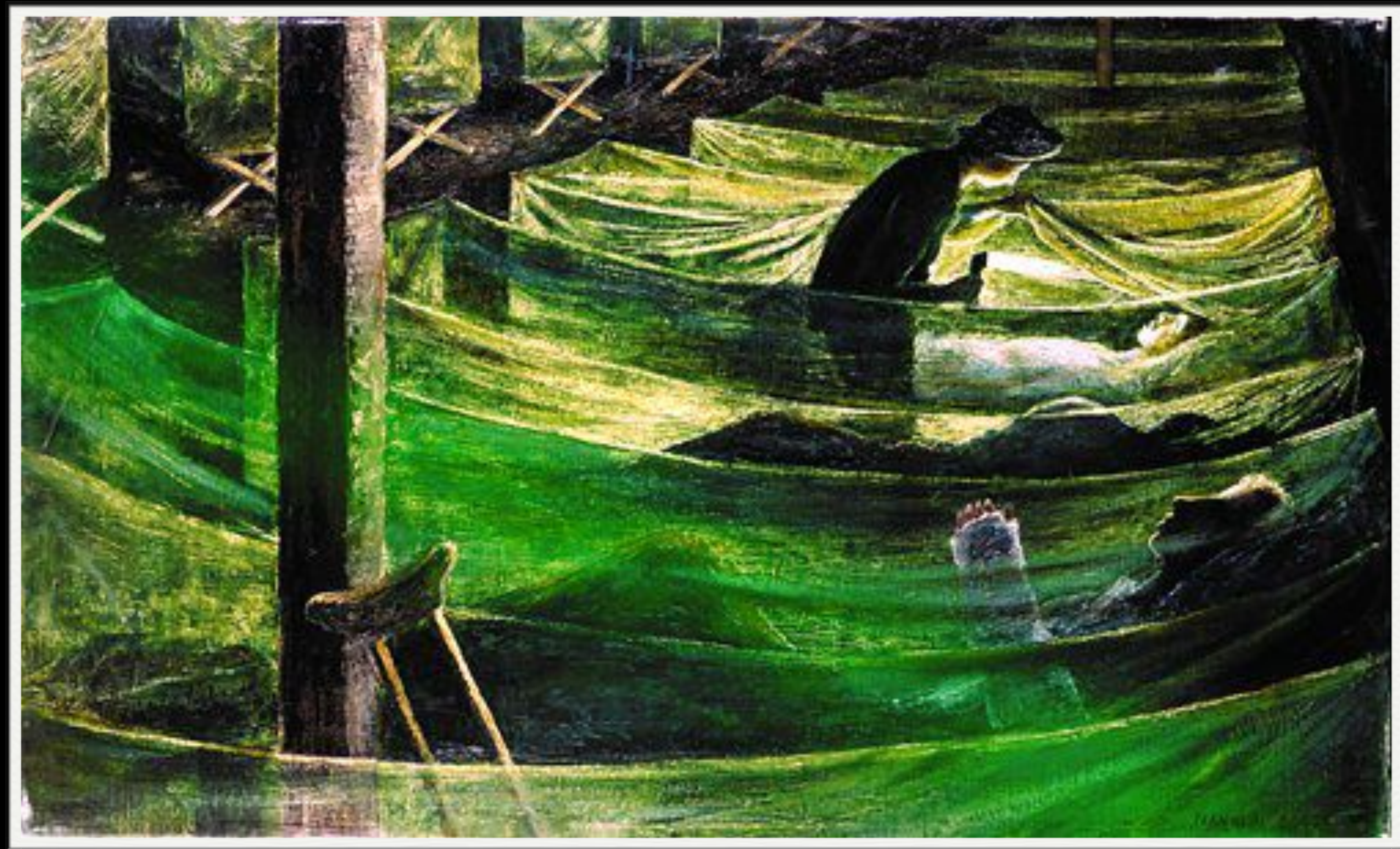

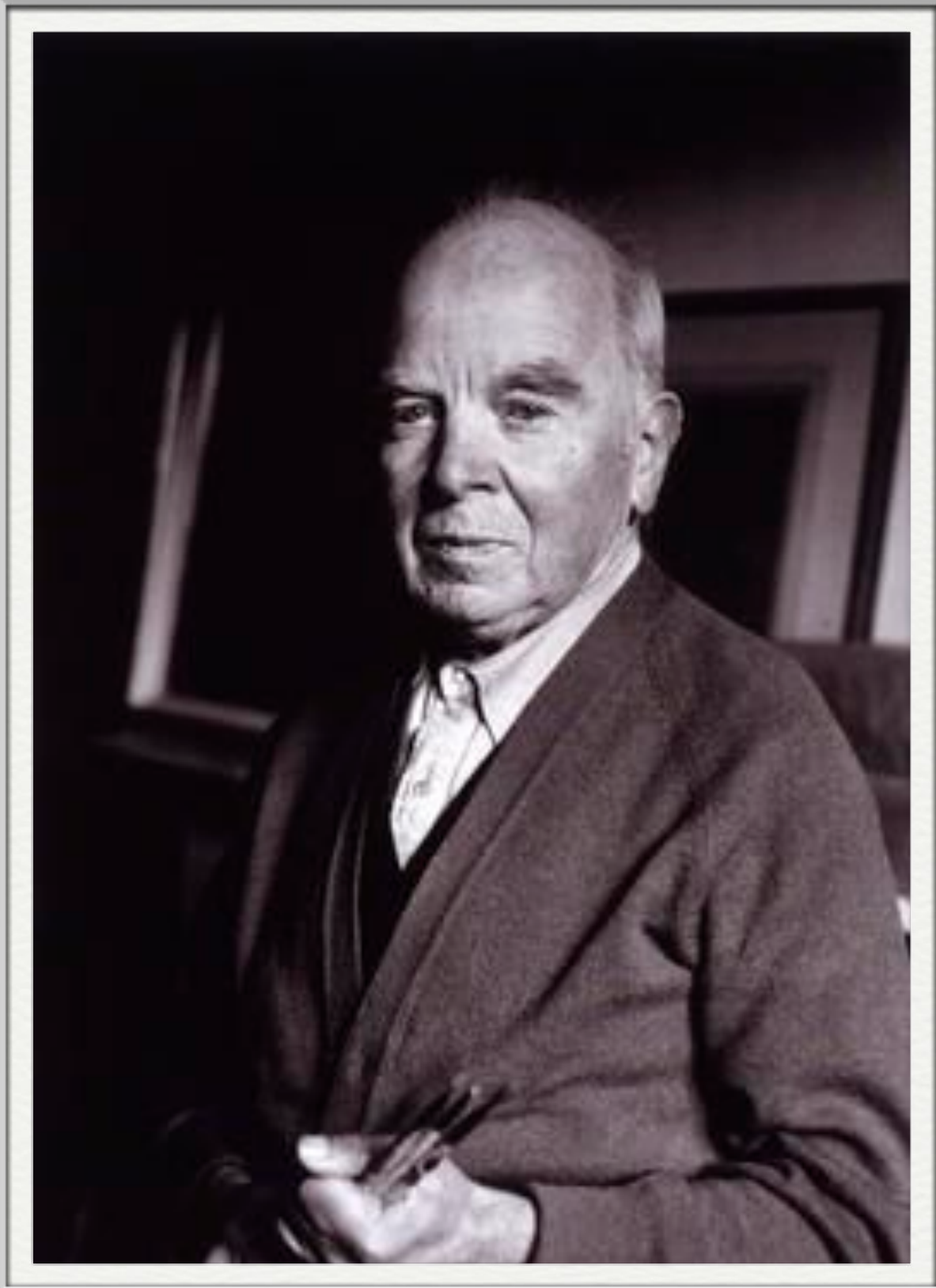

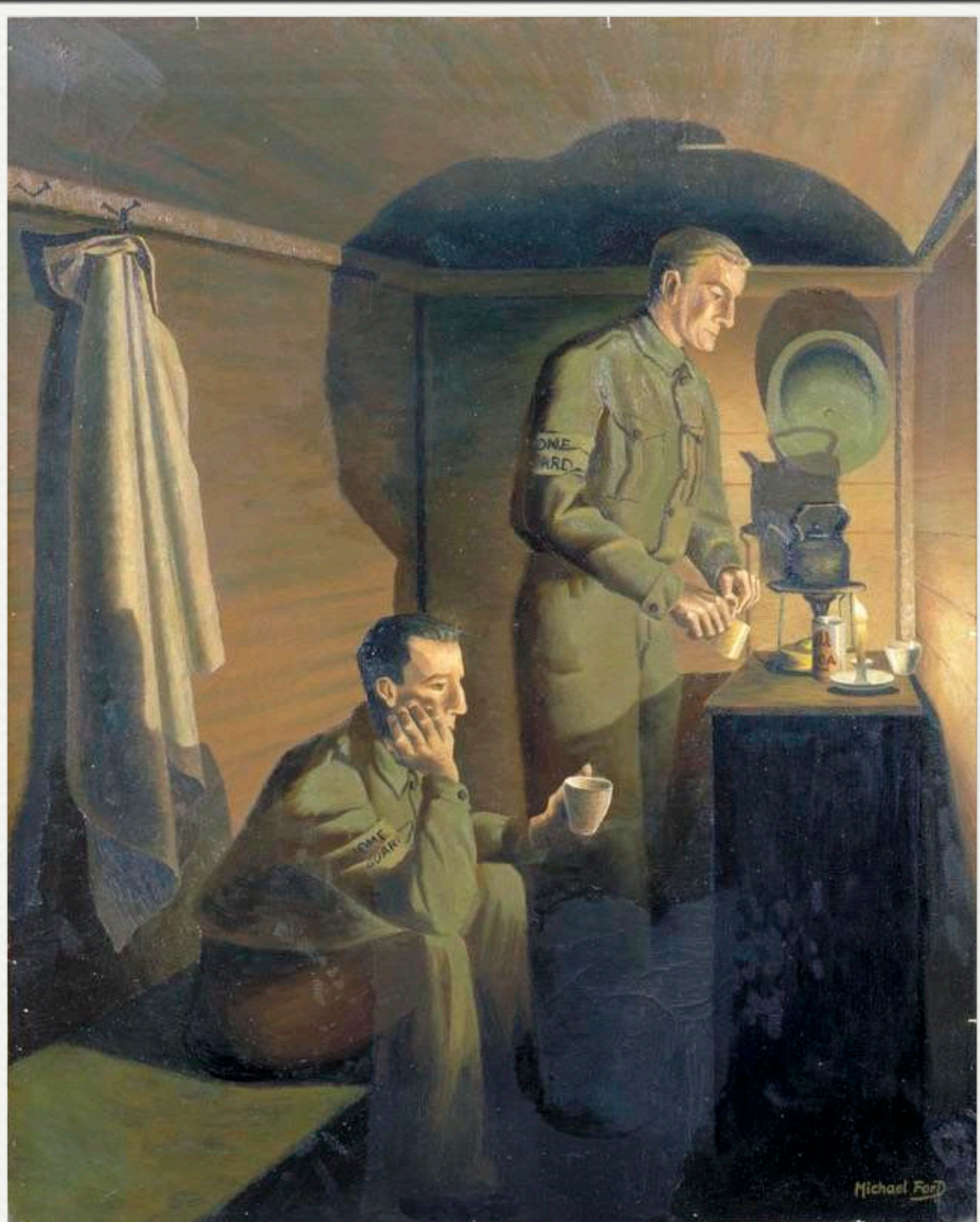

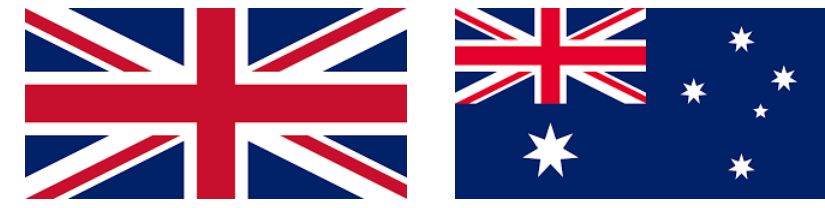

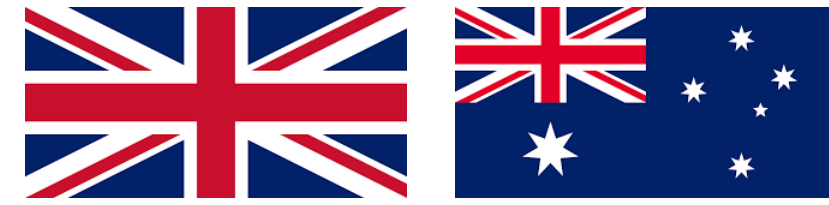
